In Hawaiian, *Nui Loa* means big, long, and a lot. That describes our newest zipline adventure perfectly. The Zipline Trek Nui Loa combines our original five zip course with three new ziplines, each unique and distinctly different. Experience the wonder of flying above a tropical paradise on this series of thrilling ziplines. Learn about the ecology, natural history, culture, folklore, and legends of Kauai. Hike secret forest trails, aerial suspension bridges, and tunnel walkways. Be awed by our island's natural beauty. Enjoy the spectacular views of the famous Kipu Ranch- 4000 acres of beautiful, diverse terrain- from its 3000' mountains to pristine jungle valleys and rivers. Jump into tumbling waterfalls and relax in refreshing mountain stream-fed waters. When you take that first step off the platform and fly off the first of eight zips, you'll be having so much fun, you'll want to do it again. So, okay, fine, we'll do this one twice.

Our second zipline combines ziplining with rappelling. You control your speed while high above a beautiful waterfall. Stop and enjoy the view if you feel like it. Go beside a partner on the 300' tandem ziplines—double the smiles and screams. More adventurous folks even have the option to go backwards and upside-down. Enjoy the spectacular sights from a series of suspension bridges and aerial walkways. Soar a thrilling 800' from the jungle treetops, over a lush valley, and land in a grassy meadow. Take a walk back in time through an irrigation tunnel, made by Kipu Ranch *paniolo*s (cowboys) nearly 100 years ago. Feel the absolute exhilaration of soaring over the jungle treetops on our 1800' tandem ziplines. That's right, eighteen hundred feet. You'll be laughing when you check the look on your buddy's face as you fly over a quarter of a mile together. Head on down to the secluded Blue Pool for a completely different kind of zipline experience. Hang on for a ride that's wild and wet. Our WaterZip is fun for everyone. Hold on, step off, and zip over a mountain stream-fed, natural swimming pool. Let go and drop down into the clear, deep water. Climb out and have another go, or just relax and float around for a while. Enjoy a delicious picnic lunch, you'll have a big appetite after all that fun. When it's all said and done, you'll be smiling every time you reminisce about your fabulous Zip Trek Nui Loa on Kipu Ranch.

Check-in: At our Poipu Shop- morning tour check-in at 7:15 am, return at 1:00 pm, afternoon tour check-in at 12:30 am, return at 6:30 pm.
