## KAUAI STAND UP PADDLE BOARD TOUR

**Paddle. Smile. Splash!**

Now having fun is as easy as standing up. From the company that introduced Zip lining to Kauai comes a brand-new adventure—the first of its kind in Hawaii: A calm-water river stand up paddle board tour. You'll paddle downwind, hike to waterfalls, ride a very cool water zip line, and much more.

Stand up paddle (SUP) boarding is the latest in watersport innovation and is taking the world by storm! Join us for a half day of discovery and see what all the fuss is about. Creek and paddle provided. After an informative and fun SUP lesson, your experienced guides will fit you with a stable, state-of-the-art SURFTECH board and paddle that are just right for you. You'll be amazed how easy it is to put your best foot forward, and...STAND UP! Paddle and glide as we cruise downwind two miles along a tranquil jungle stream. While you're perfecting your technique, enjoy the spectacular scenery of the Hule'ia National Wildlife Refuge, ringed by the majestic Hau'pu Mountains.

We'll tie our SUPs to the river bank and step from board to shore. When your toes touch solid ground, you've officially entered Kipu Ranch, where Indiana Jones ran from angry natives in *Raiders of the Lost Ark*, and dinosaurs roamed in *Jurassic Park*. We'll walk about a mile through a tropical rain forest to the secluded Blue Pool, home to everyone's favorite—the WaterZip. Just hold on, step off, and splash into the clear, deep water. Cannonball competitions encouraged. Lunch is served on a series of sunny decks above the pool. Another one-mile hike brings us back to our boards, and our motorized Hawaiian-style canoe, waiting to ferry us back up the river as our boards are towed behind it. Trade your Stand Up for a sit down, and relax and enjoy the ride.

**Check-In:** Guests staying at Poipu area or West Side resorts should check in at Outfitters Kauai in Poipu at 7:30 am, returning at 1:30 pm.

**Check-In:** Guests staying at East Side or North Shore resorts should check in at The Kayak Shack at Nawiliwili Small Boat Harbor at 8:15 am, returning at 12:45 pm.

**Refrshments:** A hearty picnic lunch consisting of a turkey or veggie wrap, pasta salad, cookie, and cold bottled spring water.

**What to wear and bring:** We recommend you bring a swimsuit, shorts, t shirt, windbreaker or light rain coat, and footwear with aggressive tread for muddy conditions. Sport type sandals with heelstraps or aqua socks with tread work great. And don't forget a hat, sunscreen, bug spray and a waterproof camera. You can buy these items at our Poipu shop, or rent sport sandals (as available) at Poipu.

**The cost:** \$122 per person plus tax for adults, \$92 plus tax for kids 14 years old and under.
